Ways to Express Love for God

Deuteronomy 10:12 And now, Israel, what doth the Lord thy God require of thee, but to fear the Lord thy God, to walk in all his ways, and to love him, and to serve the Lord thy God with all thy heart and with all thy soul,

1. "Fear Him"

To fear the Lord is to stand in awe of his majesty, power, wisdom, justice and mercy, especially in Christ - in his life, death and resurrection – that is, to have an exalted view of God. To see God in all his glory and then respond to him appropriately. To humble ourselves before him. To adore him.

2 'Walk in all His ways'

We are to walk in His ways. Obedience to God's Word is key for every Christ follower. We must read His Word, abide by it, meditate on it, stand upon it, and live it. That is what it means to walk in His ways.

3. "Love Him"

4. "Serve Him with all your heart and with all your soul'
