
## Note from David's Desk,

As I sit here this morning my mind is full of the activities of spring coming on. With spring, churches begin a series of meetings that are called revival. I am pondering the devotion I read this morning about revival. I am considering the question it raised: "What is the nature of revival?" I have read for years the stories of old about the great moves of God as revival broke out around our country. I have often wondered what it might be like. 
