# From the Director's Desk

his morning I am thinking of several things I need to share with the I Green River Association members and friends. I have been doing some demographic work for our associational area. In the process of doing this I have come across the NC Baptist work on the "The Pockets of Lostness." If you go to their website, you will find a map of the state with these pockets all over our state. If you enlarge the part of the state we live in and you move in on Rutherford County, you will find three of these pockets marked out in Rutherford County.

Now before I continue, I need to define what makes up a "Pocket of Lostness." Here is how our state convention does that.

POCKETS OF LOSTNESS are small geographic areas about three to six miles in diameter with a large percentage and high concentration of lost people. Based on demographic data, approximately 70% of the population who live in these places are unchurched. We have identified 250 distinct pockets of lostness in North Carolina. These are places where the general population is growing or changing faster than the church. Each pocket also has its own distinct barriers to gospel ministry.

Here are three such pockets in Rutherford County. Number 160 is in Mooresboro, number 188 is right in Forest City and then lastly you have number 189 centered at 183West 5<sup>th</sup> Street in Rutherfordton. Think about this for a minute. If you GPS that address from the Green River office, you will find it is .9 miles from the office.

Now let me share some information about this Pocket of Lostness. This pocket is centered in the town of Rutherfordton. There is a total of 4,672 households in this pocket. Out of those households, it is estimated that there are 3,093 unreached households. That means there are 3/4's of those homes where no one is going to church. Then consider this, 80% of those homes are Anglo, and 16 % are African Americans.

I am sharing this information this morning because while we hear about the lost world out there, we need to consider the fact that the lost world is just outside our own doors. Would you pray with me that God would again burden our hearts for Rutherford County? More than that, would you pray that we would reach out to Rutherfordton. Who will open their hearts to be used by God to reach our neighbors in our own county? You don't even have to buy an airplane ticket to go and do that.

On another note, in March we are going to be heading back to Red Spring Mission Camp to work with Re-Build after last year's hurricane season. The dates are March 26-28<sup>th</sup>. If you are interested in going contact our office to


